Student Art Show Rules and Regulations

- Participants may enter a single work created by them alone and/or a collective work created by many. The work can be made in school or outside of school, at home or in a workshop or class. It may be 2- or 3-dimensional or AV and digital.
- Collective works created by several students either in or outside of school might be a film, quilt, music, etc. Attach an entry form.
- Two dimensional entries cannot exceed 18" x 24". Each must be neatly mounted, matted, or framed and ready to hang. Attach an entry form to the back of each piece.
- Three dimensional entries cannot exceed 16" H x 16" W x 16" D. Each must be ready for display, either free standing or hanging. Attach an entry form to each piece.
- AV and digital entries. Please contact the VMHA with instructions for set up and equipment needed; or to pose questions.
- Collective works. Please contact the Museum with dimensions and instructions for hanging; or to pose questions.
- Entries must not have been shown previously at VMHA.
- Entries will not be judged.
- *Delivery of Art Options:* Deliver artwork to the Valdez Museum at 217 Egan Drive by March 7th, 2020, 5 p.m.
 - OR give art to classroom teacher
 - OR leave art in art boxes located in Valdez Public Schools.
- The VMHA will return all art created in public schools to classrooms at the conclusion of the show. Other art may be picked up at the museum the week of May 4th.
